Graduating magna cum laude is often a prestigious reward for hard work in undergraduate or graduate work. The designation is less prestigious than summa Cum Laude, Magna, Summa, Honor Role, Graduating With Honors, Mean, Definition, Requirements, GPA, Convocation, College, High School, Initiation, EnglishEdit. EtymologyEdit. From Latin summā cum laude ("with the greatest praise"). ... (highest of three degrees of praise): cum laude, magna cum laude Summa cum laude = "with highest honor" ... Magna Cum Laude: Bachelor's students who earn a cumulative grade point average of 3.67-3.749.. The summa cum laude distinction means "of (or with) the highest honors", and is sometimes only awarded to one individual per batch of graduating students.. Magna cum laude is the next level up, meaning something like great honors, Summa cum laude means greatest honors. Each university sets their own 3.700 - 3.899 GPA = Magna Cum Laude; 3.900 - 4.000 GPA = Summa Cum Laude. Grade point averages used to determine Latin honors designations are Summa cum laude in a field: Highest Honors from concentration; GPA in top 5% of graduating class. Magna cum laude: No more than 20% of The Latin Honor designation is in three categories, each with its own minimum GPA requirement: Summa Cum Laude (With Highest Honor) – 3.9000 GPA; Magna Summa cum laude graduates comprise the top 2% of the class, magna cum laude the next 10%, and cum laude the next 20%.
